 <p><b>Projects</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Doing work your teachers ask you to do, like research or typing</li> <li>• Doing activities for learning</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Doing personal things like watching videos on-line</li> <li>• Playing games that are not for learning</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Research</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Looking up information for school</li> <li>• Saying where you found the information</li> <li>• Writing down your research in your own words</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Looking up information that is not related to your learning</li> <li>• Downloading things you don't own (music, video, pictures etc.)</li> <li>• Taking or using things that don't belong to you (plagiarizing, stealing)</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Communication</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sending your work between home and school, or to others</li> <li>• Sharing your ideas</li> <li>• Writing, speaking or showing your ideas</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sending messages that are untrue, mean, hurtful or interrupt learning.</li> <li>• Sending personal messages</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Safety</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Keeping your name, telephone and address private</li> <li>• Telling an adult or teacher when something bad happens</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Accessing or sharing inappropriate language, pictures or text</li> <li>• Sharing your password</li> <li>• Ignoring logging off</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Protecting Tools</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Telling an adult or teacher if something is broken</li> <li>• Asking for help before using a laptop or other tool on the school's network</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Damaging the network or the computers so that others can't use them (unplugging, viruses, hacking etc.)</li> <li>• Putting programs on the computer that the school did not agree to, or using your own tools on the computer</li> </ul>
